



## PREFACE

Towards the end of July, 1992, I received a letter from a brother in the message. He had read my brochure, “... **Earth Earth, Hear The Word Of The Lord**”, and he seemed to enjoy it; but he wanted me to elaborate on the issue of the Seven Thunders, which he couldn't quite make out. Following this letter, I wrote a seven page letter, bringing out from the Scriptures, and from the message of the prophet, what the Seven Thunders relate to: The prophetic ministry of seven anointed men for the end time Bride.

However, on receiving my exposition, and having laid it against his own understanding of the quotes, rather than lay it on the Scriptures, to have the right understanding of the words of the prophet, he wrote to say I misunderstood the prophet on the issue, and hence misrepresented his words. **He disagreed with the things I wrote, without the slightest recourse to the Bible.**

I then gave his letter, together with my explanation, to a brother to read. And this in essence is what the brother said to me, having read it: Brother Segun, this is a very good write-up that should be made into a

tract to help God's children see the truth of the ministry of the Seven Thunders. You brought it out so plainly that one does not even need to have a revelation to see it.

I prayerfully thought over it, and when convinced of it, and I felt the urge within me to do it, I sat down to put the write-up in tract form. However, before I was mid-way through, and I realized I still had a lot to write, I knew I could never bring it out as a tract, for it was just too much. I decided to take my time and deal extensively with the issue, once and for all, as God would give grace.

However, when going over the quotes of the prophet in the Seven Seals book I had used, and was going to use, to shed light on the things I was bringing out of the Scriptures, I realized it also contained some statements that carnal minds would stumble over and use to cause confusion, for lack of Scriptural understanding. I therefore decided to leave out the quotes entirely, and base the whole thing strictly on the Scriptures of truth.

Moreover, I believe, if you would have no regard for the Scriptures, you would neither have regard for any quote of the prophet I bring, no matter how Scriptural, for you would always have a contrary quote to hold

onto. That is apart from the settled Scriptural fact, that a quote does not establish a teaching, however plausible it may seem, without a Scriptural base; for **God's Word alone is truth** (Jn. 17:17).

The result is this brochure.

May the Lord bless you as you read.

## TEXT

## **PRELUDE TO THE SEVEN THUNDERS**

I know this is one issue a lot of message people get scared of, because to them, it is like going into the deep sea or muddled water, and people fear being drowned or dirtied. But so do the denominational world hold the book of Revelation and the message of the prophet to this age. They don't touch it, they don't want it. To them it is a muddle, not realizing that you sometimes have to go through the muddle to get God and to follow truth. It is simply because it is not meant for them; or they would have known as in Ezekiel's vision of the Sanctuary waters, that it is a water to swim in. But we know that the book of Revelation is a love letter to the Bride by our Bridegroom, using John the beloved disciple to deliver it, just as the message of the prophet is the voice of the Spirit to Laodicea (Rev. 3:14,22).

As such, if there is any set of people on earth to have a revelation of that which is Written, and in particular, of hidden prophetic Scriptures, it is the end time Bride, and nothing therein would be hidden to them. This is particularly so, since the book of Revelation (the apocalypse) was written specifically to the Gentile Bride (Rev. 1:1-4). They are therefore the only ones that would understand it; for no verse of it was written in vain. That is why it reads: ***“Blessed is he that***

**R-E-A-D-E-T-H** and they that **H-E-A-R** (understand) **the W-O-R-D-S** (plural) of **this prophecy**, and **K-E-E-P** those **THINGS** (plural) **which are written therein: for the time is at hand**" (Rev. 1:3).

Apostle Paul wrote: **"We speak the wisdom of God in a mystery"** (that is, we couch it in a mystery), **"even the HIDDEN WISDOM, which God ordained before the world unto O-U-R G-L-O-R-Y"**(hidden truth is for our glory: Did you hear that?) **".... But God hath revealed them to us by His Spirit: for the Spirit searcheth A-L-L THINGS, yea, the D-E-E-P"** (hidden) **"things of God...."** (why?) **"that we might K-N-O-W"** (know what?) **"the things that are FREELY GIVEN to us of God"** (to know truth) - **1 Cor. 2:7-12**. If you still doubt that, then follow me to the Scriptures for additional witness.

It is categorically stated by Christ thusly: **"It is GIVEN unto you"** (the elects) **"to know"** (What?) **"THE MYSTERIES"** (plural) **"of the kingdom of heaven"** - **Matt. 13: 11**. The Bride is absolutely given to know whatever mysteries are laid out in the Bible - for the Bible is the Word of the kingdom. That is why it is written: **"The secret"** (undisclosed) **"things belong unto the Lord our God: but those things which**

**are REVEALED**” (disclosed; written) **“belong unto us and to our children for ever”** (why?), **“that we may do ALL THE WORDS of this law”** (this Bible) - **Deu. 29:29**. At least you cannot deny the fact that the Holy Scriptures (the Bible in its entirety) is the revelation of God to man -For whatsoever is written, is written that we may live by it, and by so doing, live.

That is why Jesus Christ declared: **“... Man shall not live by bread alone, but by E-V-E-R-Y W-O-R-D that proceedeth out of the mouth of God”** (Matt. 4:4). Whether mysterious or plain, it is written that we may live by it. But the question is, how can we live by things (revelations) that are mysteriously couched (written) - in the Scriptures? That is why Christ promised: **“Howbeit when he, the Spirit of truth, is come, he will G-U-I-D-E you into”** (what?) **“A-L-L T-R-U-T-H”** (all that is written) **John 16:13**. Because it is given unto you, and only unto you (the elected Bride), to know the mysteries of the kingdom! That is why you must understand that it takes those who have been dealt with by the Holy Spirit to understand these things, for **“...the natural”** (carnal) **“man receiveth not things of the Spirit of God: for they are foolishness unto him: neither can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned”** - 1 Cor. 2:14.

And that is why it is written in respect of deep (secret) spiritual truths God gave to Daniel: “...**shut up the Words, and seal the Book**” (till when?) “... **for the Words are closed up and sealed till the time of the end... None of the wicked shall understand; BUT THE WISE SHALL UNDERSTAND**” (the end time Bride shall understand, and nothing shall be hidden to them in respect of that which is written, however deep) - Dan. 12:4-10. This is a Scriptural promise, as well as a spiritual fact: The Bride shall understand. They shall no doubt possess the revelation of the seven thunders, for it is given unto them to know it. At any rate, the Scriptures cannot be broken; except one is not part of the living element of the end time Bride -except that.

We therefore do not have to fear going into the deep things of God: because “**There is no fear in love**” (and love is according to truth); “**but perfect love casteth out fear: because fear hath torment**” (it will alienate you from God and give you unnecessary heartache). “**He that feareth is not made perfect in love**” -1 John. 4:18. “**But THE FEARFUL, and unbelieving... and idolaters, and all liars**” (all those preaching lies -preaching falsehood), “**shall have their part in the lake which burneth with fire and brimstone: which is the second death**” - Rev. 21:8. Take note therefore: Fear that would fence you

away from truth and would not make you accept truth is of the devil! Fear that would deny you access to “*the hidden wisdom*” God ordained for the glory of the saints is not a godly fear! Fear that would limit you to certain portions of the Bible and would not allow you to be led into “all truth” as promised in the Scriptures is satanic! For man shall live by EVERY WORD OF GOD! Truth gives light for it is light! (Ps. 119:105,130). Truth sets free! Truth gives life! (John. 6:63).

And the fact that there is a lot of confusion and mess in the message world about the seven thunders should not make you close your eyes and ears to Bible truth! The seven thunders is nevertheless a Bible issue! And it must have its application! Truth is somewhere! There may be more than 100 versions of seven thunders for all I care, truth is still somewhere! It won't forever remain a mystery, for it is written to the saints! And God will have to use somebody to reveal it to the Bride! Cast off every shackle and yield to the Holy Spirit to lead you into truth! At least you have the Bible for your yardstick! **And if you do not have confidence in the Bible you hold, in what would you have confidence?** Think about it.

You and I know that for every move of God, and for every prophetic Scripture, particularly those that are to have a tremendous (a profound) impact on the

Bride, the devil must first move to make a mess of it to lead away his own. By the time truth comes, many are no longer interested, having fed on a lot of garbage. Many become fearful. Many become blinded. But I say again, the seven thunders is still a Scriptural prophetic Word! God must have His anointed somewhere with the true revelation! For God would not leave Himself without a true Witness, or leave the Bride in darkness -for they must understand that which is Written! And God never wrote a verse of Scripture merely to occupy space! He does not write in vain! EVERY Scripture must have its application! Only let the Bible be your guide! Lay all revelations on the Bible to know that which is true. That is the litmus test - the test of all tests. **True revelation produces consistency and harmony of the Scriptures. It won't deny any Scripture, but rather, it will give room for the application of every verse of the Bible - yet without discord!** That is the only basis for censoring a revelation - the Bible. Listen to what the Prophet said on this when preaching on the 7th Seal, on page 569, paragraph 4: ***“Now, there's many people have visions. There's many been in revelations. If it's contrary to the Word, leave it alone. That's right; leave it alone.”*** For that is the only basis for rejecting or accepting a revelation - indeed any revelation.

There are also some who could never touch the book of Revelation farther than the issues the Prophet touched upon. To them, no other minister can be used of God to reveal Scriptural truths! The rest of the things written therein is therefore for the dustbin! They might as well not have been written! Or they might as well have been written by the Spirit of the Lord in vain! See where unbelief will lead you? The Bible says the end time bride shall understand; for it is given unto them to understand the mysteries of the kingdom! Truth is marching on! Glory! Why don't you move on with truth? I would now delve into the seven thunders. But first I must lay some things. Open your heart to God to help you recognize truth while it is ringing.

## **WHAT THE SEVEN THUNDERS ARE NOT**

Before starting on what the seven thunders are, I would first like to state categorically what they are not. And I expect you to search the Scriptures! Be a Berean Christian! Don't search for quotes : That would be foolishness! Think of it, all those who hold the various versions of the seven thunders have a quote for what they hold, however ridiculous their revelation is. Furthermore, inspite of their quotes, they have not been able to convince those holding to opposing

views, but actually fight each other with quotes at their carnal ecumenic conventions, which usually end in confusion and uproar. What a babel! It clearly shows that these preachers are simply devoid of the Spirit, and hence devoid of truth: **For in Christ, there is neither perversion nor confusion, but peace, revelatory stability, soundness of mind, and unity of revelation and purpose.** It should also inform you that quoting the Prophet does not resolve anything without a Scriptural base! And where there is a true revelation of a Scriptural truth, it harmonies the Scriptures. But then, people devoid of truth can only wax worse and worse, deceiving and being deceived, increasing unto more ungodliness.

At least we understand by the Scriptures that this is the hour of the manifestation of follies of those who resist or do respite to truth. Shame and Confusion of faces belongeth unto unrevelated souls. Whilst the true saints of God are solidly planted by the rivers of water (water of the Word - Eph. 5:26,27), the **“... ungodly are not so: but are like the chaff which the wind”** (created by the fan of Matt. 3:12) **“driveth away” - Psalm 1:4.** You should therefore understand why these preachers have no Bible for what they peddle: They are not anchored in truth, and that is why they fight each other with quotes in their assemblies and at conventions, being devoid of the

Spirit, having not the revelation of the message of the Prophet. The true watchmen (ministers) of Christ shall however see eye to eye on Scriptural issues, for they would be receiving their revelations from the same source -Christ, the chief shepherd! At any rate, there is only one fold, and only one faith! The revelation faith of Jesus Christ!

There is however a key amongst others, that lets us know what the seven thunders is definitely not. It is written: ***“...and when he had cried, seven thunders uttered their voices. And when the seven thunders had uttered their voices, I”*** (John) ***“was about to write: and I”*** (John) ***“heard a voice from heaven saying unto me,”*** (unto John, who alone heard in the spirit what the seven thunders uttered), ***“SEAL UP THOSE THINGS WHICH THE SEVEN THUNDERS UTTERED, AND WRITE THEM N-O-T”*** - **Rev. 10:3 (b) & 4**. This succinctly (clearly) lets us know, without any shadow of doubt, that the message of the seven thunders are not written! It is a complete secret. This is what I call the key. Please take special notice of this Scriptural fact. In view of this fact, it is utterly absurd, for it does not stand to reason, to say that the mysterious seven thunders are seven virtues, when there is absolutely nothing mysterious or hidden about the believer having to manifest virtues: Peter and Paul had clearly laid this out in their

epistles, long before 96 A. D. when John was caught up on the Isle of Patmos and shown these things (2 Pet. 1:3-9; Gal. 5:16-25; 1 Cor. 13: 1-7). Moreover, how could John in his right mind have attempted to write the audible voices of seven virtues (if that is the interpretation you get) when virtues do not have voices, being simply attributes of the divine nature a Holy Ghost filled person manifests? Think about it. But please understand, I do not say these things to be rude, but to shake God's children out of the bondage of carnal revelation. Without the grace God, I would hold to any foolishness carnal preachers call revelation: For no man is anything of himself -We live, and are what we are, by the grace and mercy of God. But I feel it is high time a spade is called a spade. It is too late in the day. Moreover, carnal revelations profit nobody; but rather, it brings bondage and spiritual death. It also breeds confusion, for it is perversion: and God is not in it. At any rate, this is the hour that every traditional idea and carnal interpretation of men must go. For the Bride would be dressed in nothing but the pure and incorruptible revelation of truth.

Furthermore, neither is it the message of the messengers to the seven church ages, since there is nothing secret in the revelation conveyed by the Spirit through them to their respective ages, as it was

already revealed by the Spirit to John and written in Rev. 2&3! **“And unto the angel of the church of the Laodiceans write... He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches” - Rev. 3:14,22.** This opening and closing pattern runs through all the seven church ages. We are given the conditions the angels (star messengers) were to address in their ministrations in their respective ages, and their message were definitely not contrary to that which was needed to deal with the spiritual environment of their time. This in itself gives us an insight into the Message of each messenger. At any rate, apart from Paul, a foundational apostle, and indeed the Star-Messenger to the Ephesian age (the First church age), who was used of God to write most of the epistles, every other star messenger had to preach on that which is written! Moreover, Paul had passed away ever before the book of Revelation was written! There is therefore nothing secret in what they uttered (preached) or that came out of the blues! But the message of the seven thunders is not at all written! See? You can fight it if you will; but I tell you, you would have no Scriptural base for it. That's true!

It is not that the message of the seven thunders would contradict the Bible. No! Their message would not contradict the Bible. In fact, it would be a complement to it, to cap the great plan of salvation, in order to bring

redemption to fruition: For without their ministry, Christ cannot swear as in Rev. 10:5&6 that it is home going time! Hence, although their message would complement the Scriptures, you would nevertheless not find their message written anywhere! That is why it has to be, and that is why it would surely be, a prophetic message.

Moreover, we can neither take the seven thunders to be the revelation contained in the seven seals, because you don't even have one verse of Scripture to back up such a wild assumption. It's a carnal revelation -an attribute of a puffed up fleshly mind. Because you cannot assume! You must have a Scriptural base for whatever revelation you hold; for we cannot go by your wild imagination. **If the seven thunders is the revelation contained in the seven seals, what is the revelation of the seventh seal?** Answer me! This question also goes to those who say that the seventh seal has been broken: **Please explain to me by the Scriptures what the revelation of the seventh seal is, just as we can easily and Scripturally explain the revelation of seals one to six.** Your sins shall find you out! Moreover, at the Scriptural opening of the seals, there was only one thunder, not seven! And it thundered only at the opening of the first seal! (Rev. 6). There was no thunder in the second, third, fourth,

fifth or sixth seal. Search the Scriptures! You would have to disdain God's Holy Writ to believe that the seven thunders is the revelation of the seven seals: Because it is obviously a lying vanity! But then, not all men have faith. See?

There are some who also hold that the seven thunders is the entire message of the Prophet to this age. This is simply playing with truth: because you don't have one verse of Scripture to back that up either! And you don't play around with truth. Because it is the business of tares to do that. Listen to me: There is absolutely nothing the Prophet preached on that is not written! He didn't get serpent seed out of the blues! It is right there in the Scriptures, although hidden from our understanding, until the Lord used the Prophet to open our eyes to it. We can now show others right in the Scriptures, why the original sin was sex (for pleasure), and how the serpent seed came about. But the message of the seven thunders is not even written!

Tell me, how can the seven thunders ever be the message of the Prophet when all he preached were on things which are written? It amounts to a wild irresponsible negation of the Word of God to hold and preach such nonsense. Preachers are toying with the souls of men. It takes a two-by-four preacher to do

that. And you would have to walk over the Bible to believe such foolishness. Moreover, no one man can fulfill the seven thunders. **And if you take the “voice” of the seventh angel in Rev. 10:7 to be the message of a human messenger, and not that of a spirit angel, what would you take “voices” (plural) of the “seven thunders” in verses 3&4 to mean? And what would you also call the seven thunders? Would you, like a crow, change your voice to say that the “voices” are not messages? Would you also say that the seven thunders are literal thunders? Truth shall be your judge; for if you spiritualize one, you must spiritualize the other; and if you literalize one, you must also literalize the other.**

***“But in the days of the voice of the seventh angel, when he shall begin to sound, the MYSTERY of God should be FINISHED, as He hath declared to his servants the Prophets” - Rev. 10:7.*** Please note, “the mystery” (singular) referred to in this verse, which mystery is to be finished (completed), is not implying that the prophet would reveal all Bible mysteries, because I will tell you right away that mysteries abound in the Bible that he did not reveal. For instance, the identity of the 2 Jewish men who would constitute the 2 witnesses of Revelation 11 is still a mystery! And although they are on the earth

right now, yet, we do not know who they are, for their ministry is not yet activated, and would not be activated until the very beginning of the last week of Daniel. Note that the Bride would witness the opening of this week (2 Thess. 2:1-3).

Also, the message of the seven thunders is still a mystery, because their message is not even written! Otherwise, I would ask you to tell me what their message is. The identity of the seven persons (men) to constitute the seven thunders is still a mystery! The seventh seal is still a mystery! Brother Branham did not give us the revelation of what the two mysterious trees in the midst of the garden of Eden really are: Brother Jackson did. But the Lord did not give the revelation until the Prophet was taken off the scene, to bring about continuity of Scriptural revelation. The Prophet did not give us the revelation of the Everlasting gospel in Revelation 14, Brother Jackson did; just as it was Brother Jackson that was used in giving the Scriptural revelation or exposition of the pre-historic world concealed in Genesis 1. Where the Jewish element that would constitute the woman of Revelation 12 would run to hide in the 3 ½ years of the great tribulation period was a mystery till Brother Jackson recently opened it up revelatorily for the Bride. I could go on listing, but the instances cited are more than enough to convince the wise, the elected Bride.

The “Mystery” (singular Mystery) talked about in this verse (Rev. 10:7), is the mystery of the grafting-in of the Gentiles into Christ, which grafting started in the first age, by the first angel, and is to be completed (finished) by the message (voice) of the messenger to Laodicea (the seventh angel). In other words, the mystery relates to how the Gentiles would be fellow heirs of salvation with the Jews. This mystery, which the Lord started accomplishing in the first church age through Paul, is already laid out in the epistles (see Eph. 3:1-9; Rom. 16: 25-26; Eph. 1:9-10; Rom. 11:25-26; Col. 1:25-27). The prophet's message finishes it. It completes the grafting -in process of the Gentile bride. That is why his message has had to go round the world, **till the last elected is caught and brought in, to complete (finish) the mystery.** That is what Paul the first Star-Messenger was referring to in his epistle to the Gentile church in **Rom. 11: 25 & 26: “For I would not, brethren, that ye should be ignorant of THIS MYSTERY”** (singular-a particular mystery), **“lest ye should be wise in your own conceits; that blindness in part”** (not total blindness) **“is happened to Israel”** (Why? For what purpose?), **“UNTIL THE FULNESS”** (full or complete number) **“OF THE GENTILES BE COME IN”** (that is, into Christ -that is the mystery) **“... And so all Israel shall be**

**saved...**” (once the Gentile Bride is fully grafted in, salvation falls back to the Jews).

Even Peter initially did not know of this mystery, and hence, the Lord had to deal with him supernaturally before he could preach to the Gentile household of Cornelius at Caesarea in Acts 10. Even at that point, he still was not fully aware of this mysterious grafting in plan of God. However, Paul laid it out succinctly when he wrote: ***“For this cause I Paul, the prisoner of Jesus Christ for you Gentiles, If ye have heard of the dispensation of grace of God which is given me to you-ward: How that BY REVELATION He”*** (the Lord) ***“made known unto me THE MYSTERY: (as I wrote afore in few words, Whereby when ye read, ye may understand my knowledge in THE MYSTERY” (singular) “OF CHRIST) Which in other ages was not made known unto the sons of men, as it is NOW REVEALED unto” (who?) ***“His holy apostles and prophets”*** (New Testament Prophets) ***“by the Spirit;”*** (what is this mystery?) ***“THAT THE GENTILES SHOULD BE FELLOW HEIRS, AND OF THE SAME BODY, AND PARTAKERS OF HIS PROMISE IN CHRIST BY THE GOSPEL”*** (That is the mystery. The Lord will finish this mystery by the voice of the seventh angel) ***“.... And to make all men see what is the fellowship of THE MYSTERY, which from the beginning of the world hath been******

**hid in God” - Eph. 3:1-9.** The Old Testament scrolls contained prophecies, pointing to the fact that the nations of the earth shall be blessed through Abraham. But the Jews who carried these prophecies did not know what it pertained to, or how it would be fulfilled, nor did they know that the Gentiles would be partakers with them of Christ the Messiah King.

You would therefore understand that this mystery is not something new or something that is peculiar to the prophet of our age. The mystery was started by the first age apostles and prophets: Thus saith the Word of God. I went into this issue only to show that you cannot use **“the mystery”** referred to in Revelation 10:7 to hold that every other mystery in the Bible was finished, as to suggest that the mystery of the seven thunders was also completed by the message or ministry of the prophet, as that is not what it relates to, but of the completion of the grafting in of the Gentiles into Christ through the preaching of the gospel, and for which reason we have the star messenger to this seventh and final age.

Hence, Revelation 10:7 as of necessity fulfils ever before the application or consideration of Revelation 10:1-6, or ever before the breaking of the seventh seal. That should be clear to you. I would

endeavour to shed further light on this issue. But you must realize that Brother Branham used Revelation 10:7 “mystery” the way he did, because he was a major prophet, and one whose ministry the verse pertained to; or else, you would be blinded by such usage. **You've got to have your eyes on Scripture !**

Also note, immediately the seven thunders uttered their voices, Christ the mighty angel swore (Rev. 10:4-6) that time would no longer be (that is, that time was over): This is in respect of the catching away of the Bride (the day of redemption), and of God's dealing with Israel (Rom. 11:25 &26). If you therefore say that the seven thunders is the total message of the prophet, do you realize what you are saying? You are implying that redemption is over. Why are these same preachers still running the roads with sermon books holding meetings and crusades? Why baptize new converts? That is apart from the obvious fact that many of them would not have had the opportunity of being in the message if it was so. They are simply a confused bunch!

Seeing that the imagination of carnal minds run so wild and there is no telling the extent to which they would go, and what they could pock up, I feel that the few references made, amongst so many carnal

revelations of what the seven thunders are said to be, suffices. We can now move to deal squarely with what they really are, as laid down in the Holy Writ.

## **THE SEVEN THUNDERS**

Let's turn to Revelation 10, the only place where it is dealt with in the entire Bible. Please watch every Word, every verse, and every symbol, the totality of which gives us a very clear picture.

**VERSE 1: “AND I”** (John) **“SAW ANOTHER MIGHTY ANGEL”** (do what?) **“COME DOWN FROM HEAVEN”**: Where do you think John was positioned in the spirit to see this angel come down from heaven? “Come” means to draw near or move towards, while “go” means to move away from. He was obviously positioned on earth in the spirit or he could not have said he saw the angel come down from heaven. If he was positioned in heaven in the vision, he would have said he saw the angel go down. Hence, earth is the setting.

**“ANGEL..... CLOTHED WITH A CLOUD: AND A RAINBOW WAS UPON HIS HEAD”**: This mighty angel is undoubtedly portraying the image of Jesus Christ, also described in Malachi 3:1 as the

messenger of the covenant. The rainbow speaks of God's majesty Christ is veiled with. See God's rainbow covenant with Noah after the flood in Genesis 9:8-17. This description, amongst others we shall also see, therefore, enables us to know the identity of the one portrayed. And the fact that Christ is revealed by an angel anointed of God to express Christ's image, shows that Christ would manifest himself here in the spirit, not in the physical.

**“...AND HIS FACE WAS AS IT WERE THE SUN, AND HIS FEET AS PILLARS OF FIRE”:** Go back to Revelation 1:13-16, and you would see this same description. It speaks of Jesus Christ who stood our judgment, but is now veiled with the full authority and majesty of the eternal Spirit (Elohim).

**VERSE 2: “AND HE HAD IN HIS HAND A LITTLE BOOK O-P-E-N”:** This little open book is actually a scroll. It is the book of redemption sealed with seven seals in Revelation 5 which John wept over, which book no mortal could look upon, touch or open: but Jesus Christ, being our able and worthy kinsman redeemer, having paid the price, that is, the giving of his soul as an offering for sin, took the book and sat on the mediatorial throne to start his intercessory ministry as Melchisedec, our great High priest, for the royal seeds of Abraham. He has been sitting on that

intercessory throne with that little book in his hand, for almost 2000 years now.

The fact that all seven seals with which the book was initially sealed had been broken, making the scroll book an open book in the vision, certainly speaks or presupposes that redemption was over - his intercessory days were over for the Church (the Gentile Bride), and he could as such now prepare the Bride for the take-off, that is, for the translation of the saints called rapture; and for which reason he makes this secret appearance on earth **in the spirit**. Note this fact very well. We shall still come back to it as we progress.

It is however important to point out before we move on, that at the moment, there is a seal (the seventh seal) that is left to be broken by Jesus Christ our Lord - a seal that is still holding him (Christ) on the throne, until all the redeemed of the Lord in the entire Gentile world are fully purchased. Then and only then can the last seal be broken (that is, breaking the spiritual bond (seal) that holds it, and revealing same) to make the book an open book; for with the breaking comes the revealing (Rev. 6:1-3). And although six seals were broken in 1963, which actual event John was caught up and projected in the spirit to preview in 96 A.D., we still have the Seventh Seal untouched,

although John was also transported in the spirit to preview it's breaking, which is to take place in this same Laodicean setting. It's right ahead of us. However, the Lord alone holds the time. This seventh seal therefore holds Christ on the mediatorial throne, until the full number of Gentile elects be fully purchased according to Romans 11:25 & 26, to finish the mystery of God declared in Revelation 10:7. And by the time the book becomes an open book (that is, by the time the last seal binding it is broken), it means the elects of God in the Gentile world have been fully redeemed, and Christ can therefore leave the throne for the earth, to prepare the Bride for the rapture; **for once the 7th seal is broken, Christ leaves the throne.** The seven thunders will give the Bride the revelation of the seventh seal at that hour.

And don't forget, seven in the numerology of God signifies completion. If you therefore say that the seventh seal has been broken, you are implying that redemption is over, and is therefore complete! See what I mean? Moreover, once the seventh seal is broken the seven trumpet angels, whose ministry is also activated by the opening of the seventh Seal, must go forth (Rev. 8:1& 2) to bring revival to the Jews under the ministry of the two Olive trees - Moses and Elijah of Revelation 11, showing that time is over for the Gentiles. **Search the scriptures!** So, if you say

the seventh seal was broken in 1963 how come Israel has not yet had her revival? And this is 1994! Where are Moses and Elijah? How come the Bride is still being restored and separated, when she would have long attained perfection, had the Seventh Seal been broken as far back as 1963! Particularly when we consider the fact that Revelation 10:1-6 must be fulfilled, to wrap up God's dealing with the Gentiles, after the seventh seal is broken (Rev. 8:1), before the seven trumpet angels in verse two of Revelation 8 are ignited for the Jews. See? Moreover, why is the 5-Fold ministry not yet manifested in its full Scriptural application? And where is the supernatural manifestation of God's power that followed the first church? I speak of the height of the open display of the miraculous as we see in the Book of Acts.

I raise these issues to let you see the foolishness of holding that the seventh seal has already been broken: because its breaking shows a finish to Gentile redemption! It signifies completion! Revival of the Jews must also by it be ignited! And that is why I stated earlier that the message of the prophet to this age (Rev. 10:7) must first have its full effect before the seventh seal can be broken, or before we consider the application of the seven thunders. This in effect means, Revelation 10:7 fulfils before verses 1-6! In fact, Revelation 10:7, as I pointed out, forms

the basis or platform for the fulfillment of verses 1-6! There is no way out of it, Scripturally speaking.

**“...AND HE SET HIS RIGHT FOOT UPON THE SEA, AND HIS LEFT FOOT ON THE EARTH”**: This picture of the stance of Christ portrays the universal dominion he (Christ) possesses. It shows that his purpose for coming down to earth in the spirit has a universal (world wide) application (effect). This basically lets us know that the application of this revelation is to the Bride, for the Bride has a universal make-up. This fact is so, particularly when we consider the little book of redemption he is holding in this vision, depicting that he is here in respect of the redeemed of the Lord to whom the little book pertains - the Bride having been fully purchased.

This revelation cannot be Scripturally controverted, particularly when we further consider the fact that when Christ shall reveal himself to the Jews in the last week of Daniel, he would be standing (in the spirit) on Mount Zion (Rev. 14:1), which is the whole summit area of Jerusalem; and when he shall reveal himself in the day of the Lord which ushers in the millennium, after the end of a period of time also scripturally known as the time of Jacob's trouble, he would be standing on **“...the mount of Olives, which is before Jerusalem on the east, and the mount of**

***Olives shall cleave***” (divide) ***“in the midst thereof toward the east and toward the west, and there shall be a very great valley; and half of the mountain shall remove toward the north, and half of it toward the south ....”*** (Zec. 14:1-5). But here in Revelation 10:2, he set his right foot on the sea, and his left foot on the earth, speaking of the Universal dominion he possesses, and the universal application his revelation has.

**VERSE 3: “AND CRIED WITH A LOUD VOICE”:** When you take this cry together with his universal stance in the preceding verse, you have the picture of one who is asserting authority - one who has achieved his purpose - one who has prevailed. The cry in this prophetic Scripture is a message, for that is what it symbolizes. He uttered something. It is not just a literal unintelligible (meaningless) cry. It is like **Isaiah 40:3**, ***“voice of him that crieth in the wilderness.....”*** The only difference in the two Scriptural settings in this respect is that, whilst we are given to know what the cry (message) of the latter (Isaiah 40:3) is, in the former setting (Rev. 10:3), it is a complete secret - it is hidden. In Matthew 25:6, we also have a midnight cry which is actually an awakening message. That should make it clear.

Secondly, notice that the cry in this verse (Rev. 10:3) is with “a loud voice”: This speaks of the urgency and the seriousness of the message (the cry). In Revelation 14 dealing with the preaching of the Everlasting Gospel which would go forth in the middle of the last week of Daniel to prepare the elect Jews as well as the Gentile foolish virgins for martyrdom during the great tribulation period, we have the first angel in verse 7 **“Saying with A LOUD VOICE...”** This is a message to be delivered at a very terrible satanic hour -an hour of the greatest apostasy there could ever be and would ever be. The “loud voice” of this angel in Revelation 14 incontrovertibly speaks of the urgency and seriousness of the message being delivered at that satanic hour. The difference between that verse and the one under consideration (Rev. 10:3) is that in the former (Rev. 14:7), we are given what the loud voice is about, whilst in the latter, it is not written -it is a secret. But it is a secret that would be caught by the seven thunders. We shall get to see this fact shortly. But first, I would like to bring in something here, that goes with this.

Because of a statement credited to the Prophet, it is commonly believed amongst the brethren in the end time message, that the loud cry of Christ in Revelation 10:3, is the voice of resurrection. They erroneously hold Matthew 27:46-53 and John 11: 43 as their basis.

In the first place, the cry of Jesus Christ in John 11: 43 was a specific and explicit call for the resurrection of Lazarus. You cannot therefore hold that every time he cries or cries with a loud voice, he is calling for resurrection! There's no Bible for such a thought, and it would therefore be most foolish to make a doctrine out of a straightforward graveside Bible account, without taking every individual account of Christ's cry into consideration.

Secondly, Matthew 27: 46-53 records two loud cries of Jesus Christ. In verse 46, the loud cry of Jesus Christ was in tongues, which was also interpreted, and therefore means just what the Scriptures declare it means! You can't fight or change that! The Holy Spirit through Matthew gave the interpretation of the cry, for it is written: **"...Jesus cried with a loud voice, saying,"** (what?) **"Eli, Eli lama Sabachthani? that is to say"** (which by interpretation means) **"My God, my God, why hast thou forsaken me?"** It is therefore Carnal, and amounts to a blatant disregard and disrespect for the Scriptures, to hold that Christ was calling for resurrection, for he definitely wasn't! Rather, it was the passionate cry to God, of an innocent man in great anguish of soul, left alone to suffer the severe pangs of the penalty of sin he was paying on behalf of man. And

although the Father was tabernacled in him in the fullness of His deity, He (the Father) did not activate His presence in the Son at this very hour, giving the flesh of the Son to suffer and his soul to experience the lonely agony of a sinful soul, cut - off from God, yet without sin, and yet with God, the eternal Spirit, still in him! I wonder what these carnal message people, like the extreme oneness people (the Jesus only people, who see nothing but Jesus as God Almighty on account of Colossians 2:9, but would neither see nor acknowledge the Sonship of God) would say to this verse, where the Son not only acknowledged he has a Father whom he called his God (by interpretation), but literally cried out in pain and agony of soul to Him! At least we know that God is God, and is God alone, a Spirit, who would neither call any other spirit or person God, nor can He cry or feel pain as a human being, nor can He die as the Son of God died. Without a true revelation of the Godhead, you would go on one limb on this verse. Nevertheless, it was a cry to God in lonely agony, not a call for resurrection.

As a matter of fact, you would see in verse 47 that, it was a similar carnal bunch standing by, at that hour of apostasy, that took the cry of Christ to mean he "***calleth for Elias***" (meaning Elijah)! But was he?

One of this same bunch in verse 48, tried to give him (Christ) vinegar to drink, presumably to quench his thirst, and Mark 15:36 records that he stood back with the rest, waiting to see if Elijah would indeed come on the scene. But what does all this reveal? They were a confused unrevelated bunch, although they also fulfilled Scriptures unknowingly.

Thirdly, verse 50 of Matthew 27 where Jesus gave another loud cry before yielding up the Ghost (that is, before dying), cannot be taken to be a call for resurrection either, for it surely wasn't! The Bible says he cried, and then gave up the ghost! But that was not before he had committed his spirit into God's hand. The cry here then, is the last agonizing cry of a man about to be liberated through death from intense agony and pain which made him cry out earlier in verse 46; a man who had faithfully run the dreadful course mapped out for him by the Father for the redemption of man. Isaiah 53 vividly portrays this picture. But because most people gloss over this text when reading it, it is usually assumed, and wrongly too, that his cry (in verse 50) on the cross, immediately preceding his death, evoked the resurrection that took place in verse 52, simply because verse 52 account **seems** (and mark my word, **seems**) to flow with the events in verse 51, and is therefore usually lumped together.

**Verse 50: “Jesus, when he had cried again with a loud voice, yielded up the ghost.**

**Verse 51: And, behold, the veil of the temple was rent in twain from the top to the bottom; and the earth did quake, and the rocks rent;**

**Verse 52: And the graves were opened; and many bodies of the saints which slept arose”.**

If we stopped right here, it would seem the resurrection occurred alongside the quaking and renting of the temple veil, as Christ cried and gave up the ghost. But if we would take a closer look at this text, we would see that whilst the veil of the temple was rent, and the earth quaked at his death, following the cry on that day, the resurrection that ensued in verse 52 was however not on the same day as is mostly thought, but was actually on the 3rd day, and it took place only after Jesus Christ had himself been resurrected! Verse 53 clearly states: **“And came out”** (the sleeping saints came out) **“of the graves”** (When? After he cried? After he died? After the quaking and renting of the temple veil? No! When?): **“AFTER HIS”** (Christ's) **“RESURRECTION”!** That is, on the 3rd day, after Christ had died, was buried, and had first been resurrected himself! It therefore

means that the account in verses 52 & 53 have to be separated from verses 50 & 51, as there are 3 days interval between the events recorded therein.

The issue therefore is, how could Christ be taken to call for the resurrection of the sleeping Old Testament Saints, when according to Scriptures, he first had to die to conquer death in order to liberate the sleeping saints from death? (Heb. 2: 14; Eph. 4:8-10). Think about it. And how could he have called for the resurrection of the saints on the cross, when he himself was only just about to die, and when in fact he had to be the first to rise from the dead? Think about it.

Moreover, he cannot even be said to be calling for an earthquake and the renting of the temple veil, for these great physical occurrences were done by God as signs to attest to his Sonship of God at his hour of death. In fact, darkness engulfed the land from the 6th to the 9th hour when he gave up the ghost, as witness against the wicked killing of the Son of God. And that is exactly the reaction it invited from some people in verse 54, which verse should have come before verses 52 & 53, to follow verse 51, if the accounts were written in their chronological sequence of fulfillment. But God juggled the recording of these events to blind the wise and the prudent of this world.

However, when you look at **Revelation 10:3**, what does it say? **“And cried”** (that is, Christ cried) **“with a loud voice, as when a lion roareth:”** (but watch what the Scripture says happened, consequently upon his cry): **“And when he had cried, SEVEN”** (plural) **“THUNDERS”** (plural) **“UTTERED”** (spoke forth) **“THEIR”** (plural) **“VOICES”** (messages-plural). Where does resurrection come into the picture here? And immediately they gave their messages, Christ swore that rapture was no longer to be delayed (verses 4-6). Let me round up this issue by saying, you would have to walk over the Bible to hold to such lying vanity that the cry in Revelation 10:3 was a call for resurrection; for it definitely wasn't. That is that. We now move to the next thought laid out in Revelation 10:3.

**“...CRIED.... AS WHEN A LION ROARETH”**: This clause also identifies Jesus Christ, portrayed by this angel, the Lion of the tribe of Judah -The King of the whole earth! One who has dominion! That is why I say it is the voice of one asserting authority, even as a literal lion does, being the King of the jungle! And that is why you have to understand that it is not a mere cry as when one is screaming. This is symbolic language: because Christ is not a mad man, nor does he (being immortal) need to give off pressure, so to say, like men do. He uttered something very serious, very

urgent, very deep (a secret) in the spirit.

**“AND WHEN HE”** (Christ) **“HAD CRIED”** (uttered his message), **“SEVEN THUNDERS UTTERED”** (spoke forth) **“THEIR”** (plural) **“VOICES”** (plural) : That is why I say this is not a literal cry, but is symbolic of certain things Christ spoke (in the spirit). It was given to John in a pictorial (symbolic) manner. Notice: Immediately Christ gave his message in the spirit, the ministry of the seven thunders was ignited by it (by the cry). Their spiritual antennas caught what Christ uttered, and they instantly began to declare his message. It is like the 144,000 Jewish ministers who would preach the Everlasting Gospel to the whole earth: They would sound forth what the angels are uttering in the spirit (Rev. 14:6-12); Since you and I know that angels do not preach, but actually give the message God sends them to men who do the preaching. Halleluyah! You can't help but see this fact. It is so plain. See Amos 3:8.

Notice also, “Voice” is voice; it's utterance. It means message: **“THE VOICE of him that crieth in the wilderness”** (Isaiah 40:3), speaks of the message of John the Baptist being preached in the wilderness of Judea; **“...because they knew him not, nor yet THE VOICES of the Prophets which are read every sabbath day...”** (Acts 13:27), speaks of the

messages of the Old Testament Prophets. Two is a witness, but I will give three. In this chapter we are dealing with (**Rev. 10**), verse 7 declares: ***“But in the days of THE VOICE of the Seventh angel.....”*** speaking of the message of the Prophet, the star witness to Laodicea. Let me therefore ask you: **If “Voice” in verse 7 is a message, what is “voices” in verse 3? Would it not also be messages? If “the Seventh angel” in verse 7 is not actually a spirit angel, but merely symbolises a human being, what are “Seven Thunders” in verse 3? Would it not also be symbolic of Seven Men, particularly when you consider the plurality of “voices”, which speak of messages? Truth shall be thy judge.**

Moreover, “thunder” in scriptural prophetic language speaks of the voice of God: ***“Father glorify thy name. Then came there a voice from heaven, saying, I have both glorified it, and will glorify it again. The people therefore, that stood by, and heard it, said it thundered...”***! (**John. 12:28, 29**). That was how they heard it! Thunder therefore speaks of a message that proceeds directly from the throne of God (Also see: **Rev. 4:5; Rev. 11:19**). This means that the message of the seven thunders would be prophetic: they will receive direct from God the things they will utter. It would be a prophetic ministry to the Bride of Christ, their message being unwritten.

You should therefore be able to see beyond any shadow of doubt what **Revelation 10: 3** seven thunders are about, even if we did not go any further: **“Seven”** (plural) **“thunders”** (plural) **“uttered”** (spoke forth) **“their”** (plural) **“voices”** (plural messages), are seven anointed men who would utter prophetically to the Church (the Bride), once the Seventh Seal is broken, and Christ comes to earth in the spirit. But Christ would have to cry first before they give their message. In fact, it is the cry of Christ that would ignite their ministry. It is as plain as day. And the fact that they are seven men ignited by the same cry (message) of Christ, shows that they would prophetically speak the same message to the Bride. They would be seven men, strategically located around the world to effectively reach the Bride in the whole earth with their message, in view of the lateness of the hour, and the shortness of time they have within which to achieve their purpose.

**VERSE 4: “AND WHEN THE SEVEN THUNDERS HAD UTTERED THEIR VOICES, I WAS ABOUT TO WRITE”**: Don't forget that John was viewing this while he was caught up in the spirit and transported to this 20th century setting to view this event which is to take place shortly. Notice that in this verse, John heard the message of the seven thunders: That is why he wanted to write it! He heard what the seven

thunders uttered much enough to want to write it; and that is why I say he was only having a preview of the ministry of the seven thunders.

**“...AND I HEARD A VOICE FROM HEAVEN SAYING UNTO ME”** (unto John): This strengthens what I have been saying, that all these were happening right on earth; otherwise he could not have heard a voice from heaven! What did the voice say?

**“...SEAL UP THOSE THINGS WHICH THE SEVEN THUNDERS UTTERED, AND WRITE THEM NOT”**: Note that certain things were uttered by the seven thunders, and John heard the things uttered. He was however instructed not to write **those things**. The sealing up of the words (or messages) John heard the seven thunders utter, is similar to the sealing up of the Words (or revelations) Daniel was privileged to receive in Daniel 12: It is a Holy Ghost secret and is therefore totally concealed by the Spirit of God. However, notice, that John was not only told to seal up the things uttered by the seven thunders, he was also forbidden to write them. The message of the seven thunders is not written. It is a total secret. That's the difference! Daniel wrote the revelations he received although sealed. John however was not even allowed to write this particular revelation -the revelation given by the seven thunders. The Bible is so plain here; it

really needs no explanation. But like I earlier pointed out, the fact that the message of the seven thunders is not written does not imply that their message would contradict Bible. Never! It must complement it; **for no true prophet of God can disannul what another prophet of God has laid down, irrespective of his anointing. In fact no true prophet of God would contradict the “Scripture of truth”, for it is forever settled in heaven. Moreover, God magnifies His Word above His own name (Ps. 138:2), because on it hangs the honour and integrity of God. Hence it is written: “...Let God be true, but every man a liar; as it is written, That thou” (God) “mightest be justified in Thy (His) sayings...” (Plural) -Romans 3:4.** Nevertheless, the fact still remains that the message of the seven thunders is nowhere written in the Bible! It is a total secret -a secret of the Holy Ghost.

Notice also that they uttered their message at the same time, immediately Christ gave his cry in the spirit. As such, it would have been near impossible for John to write it, if they uttered different things, that is, if they uttered in a babel, seeing they uttered at the same time! This fact buttresses the point I was trying to make that the seven thunders will speak in unison -that is, they will speak with one voice, although prophetically. They will utter prophetically to the

Bride, revelations they receive direct from the throne of God; but their prophetic utterances will carry the same message (or thought or revelation), and it will have the same effect on the Bride around the world: Because they will receive from the same source, and God will be giving them the same utterances (messages) - the last flight instructions to the bride. So don't ever think that there will be disharmony in their prophetic utterances. Spit out such a thought; Jeremiah will never contradict Isaiah! That is settled!

In laying down the revelation of the seven thunders, Brother Jackson brought out this issue beautifully when he likened the seven men (thunders) to seven loud-speakers strategically placed around the world, wired to one engine: you know that whatever comes from the engine is what the seven speakers will emit. Moreover, whatever comes out of one speaker is what you will hear from the others. That is that. But please permit me to slot in something here, before we move to verse 5.

## **IN DEFENSE OF A STAND**

A minister in the message made a remark to a brother on one of my brochures, “....Earth, Earth, Hear the Word of the Lord”, to this effect: ***“I like what Brother***

**Segun wrote except that it has a flair of Jackson”.**

I do not know what he means by that. But I know you've got to be influenced by some minister or other! The issue however is, what is the basis? Let me therefore say this: I find no shame in standing for truth, but profound joy. That is why I find no shame in standing with Brother Branham in his teachings. And if I find no shame in standing with Brother Branham, I can find no shame in standing with Brother Jackson either, for it is on the same basis of truth; **for I cannot be a secret believer!** Saints, if something is true, I want to lay my life on it.

**I ask you: Would you accuse Peter of standing for a man or of preaching a man simply because he commended Paul's writings to the seeds of God in his epistle? (2 Pet. 3:15, 16).** Let the word be thy judge. If we recognize Luther, Wesley, Knox, Calvin, Branham, for the place they occupy within the plan of God in reaching God's children with truth, shouldn't we recognize others also used of God in the same vein? **Saints, I want to recognize and give room for every chosen vessel of God, dead or living, for the place he occupies in the plan of God, in reaching out and affecting God's children with truth.** Call me any name you want to: This I know, the wise shall understand, and God will Vindicate who has truth at the end of the day.

**And although we cannot and must not lift up any man beyond measure, neither can we deny the place they occupy in the plan of God, in shedding light. That is exactly right.** I know a lot of message people will stumble at this name, as the denominational people stumble at the name of Branham. It is the same spirit. And it would be because they are not ordained to walk in the path of truth. Otherwise, the name won't make a difference, for truth is truth! Moreover, if this man be not of God, he would never see or teach the rich and deep Scriptural things he gives. That shouldn't make you mad or jealous; it should make you happy for the light of the Son of God that is shining through him and other ministers of God at this final hour.

At any rate, we are not playing a game of hide and seek! It's too late in the day. Moreover, standing for truth is not based on tribal or racial sentiments! It's a serious hour. And if you received the teachings of the Prophet by the Holy Spirit, you would definitely receive any and every other teaching ministered by other men ordained of God, that flashes with the Bible, whoever they may be. This is an hour we must speak up, and speak up plainly: for there won't be another age after this. He that hath an ear, let him hear.

I would therefore say, you would never be able to accuse me of preaching a man if your eyes are open. But you could accuse me of saying that I stand with, for I believe Brother Jackson, is a minister of Jesus Christ, who preaches truth. But please don't bring in the Corinthian Carnal picture of **“One saith, I am of Paul; and another, I am of Apollos”** to condemn my stand - because I not only believe and stand with the Paul of our day (i.e. Branham) in his teachings, I also believe and stand with Apollos (i.e. Jackson), for they are glaringly one in Christ, on account of truth: one plants, the other waters. But if they were not one in Christ, standing for and preaching the same thing, I could never stand for both, for I cannot stand confusion!

Also somebody in “the message” wrote me over 2 years ago, over the same book, “....**Earth, Earth...**” implying that I wrote the things I wrote because I was looking for Brother Jackson's sponsorship. But that is just plain carnality, for sponsorship even by the Prophet does not confer a calling! Otherwise, you would only be usurping authority! It is the sponsorship of God alone that counts; for if God calls, not only will heaven's resources be at your disposal and God's true seeds stand with you, the whole of hell will bow at your feet! So, whose sponsorship is material? The sponsorship of man, indeed any man,

no matter his anointing, will never make you what you are not. It has got to be God or you've got nothing! However, I do not blame the brother for thinking this way, although he is blind, or he would be taking the same stand with me. But the point is this, so many preachers, particularly in Africa, on account of their belly (poverty), accept and stand for a lot of foolishness some American/ Canadian ministers sell as revelations. And because such ones are not serving Christ but dollars, they have to have the sponsorship of man! May God open the eyes of the brother to truth.

In saying these things, please understand, I do not expect to given a pat on the back, for truth will put me in opposition with a lot of people. But so far it is true, and my motives are right, and God is pleased, what do I care? I could not give a hoot!

## **THE SEVEN THUNDERS CONCLUDED**

**VERSE 5: “AND THE ANGEL WHICH I SAW STAND UPON THE SEA AND UPON THE EARTH LIFTED UP HIS HAND”** (to where?) **“TO HEAVEN”**: This clearly shows that Christ was on earth all this while in the spirit. It also shows that Christ is the one directly behind the ministry of the seven thunders.

How can we therefore ever think that anybody in the Gentile world can be saved once this event takes place, seeing that Christ is off the mercy seat all this while on earth? Think about it. That is why it sounds foolish to me for preachers to say that the seven thunders ministry has been fulfilled and yet bless God for souls getting saved under their ministry! What a confused lot! What did this mighty angel lift up his hand for?

**VERSE 6: “AND SWARE BY HIM THAT LIVETH FOREVER AND EVER, WHO CREATED HEAVEN, AND THE THINGS THAT THEREIN ARE, AND THE EARTH, AND THE THINGS THAT THEREIN ARE, AND THE SEA, AND THE THINGS WHICH ARE THEREIN, THAT THERE SHOULD BE TIME NO LONGER”:**

This verse, taken with verse 5, is similar to what obtained in Daniel 12 :5-7 vision. The angel described therein lifted up his hand to heaven and swore by the living God in relation to time. In fact it is the same angel involved in both instances, except that the setting is different, and the application is different. The angel in Daniel is seen on the Euphrates River in relation to things having application to the Jews in the tribulation period.

In verse 6 of Revelation 10 we are dealing with, **Christ swore immediately the seven thunders uttered their messages** that time was over:

**“...there should be time no longer”**. This time issue is in two respects, as I pointed out earlier. Firstly, it is in respect of the catching away of the Bride, the day of redemption the Bride is waiting for. It means that once the seven thunders have delivered their message, it is home going time for the Bride, nothing delays it. Secondly, it applies to the revival of the Jews. It shows God can now start dealing with the Jews under the ministry of the two candlesticks, the two witnesses or Olive trees, Moses and Elijah of Revelation 11. In this application, you have the seven trumpet angels of Revelation 8:2 going forth.

## **A LAST WORD**

Many will readily agree that the Lord has anointed the eyes of the Bride with eyesalve through the message of the Prophet. But I ask: What is the eyesalve supposed to do? **Are you given eyesalve that your eyes may be glued to the sermon books and closed to the Bible? Or is it not rather that by the message of the Prophet your eyes are supposed to be opened to the Bible that you may know how to walk with God in the light of His Word?** How do you hear what you hear? What you hear the message people say is this: ***“Before the Prophet came, we did not understand the Bible”***, which is quite true.

**But how come the Prophet has come to give us an understanding of the Bible and you still cannot use it as your road map? How come it is still a closed book to you? That is the question!** What good then has the eyesalve done for you? Is it not a case of hearing they hear not? Otherwise you ought to be able to go in and out of the Bible, having had your eyes of understanding enlightened by the Holy Spirit through the message of the Prophet. That's true.

Let me therefore ask you: How can you look forward to God's move if you are blind to it? **And how can you avoid missing God at the hour of fulfillment, though you look forward, if you do not know just what to look forward to,** even as the scribes missed Elijah they preached about? (Matt. 17: 10-13). They were so set in their ways until when truth came, it seemed to them to have k-legs, so to say, and they turned it down. In doing that, they turned God down (Luke 7:29-30). It's unfortunate, but I would have to say, all those who claim they believe the message of the prophet, but cannot follow the continuity of light as it's being shed through other anointed men of God at this hour, must miss God: There's just no way out, except they walk in the light. If you could thank God for Luther, you ought to be able to thank God also for Calvin and John Knox, although the latter two

were not star messengers of their day! Because you ought to realize that God used these men also to shed further light to what Luther shed, if you have any representation or seed of light in your soul. I hope you get what I mean.

When the religious world turned down the Prophet to this age, that put a full-stop to God's move in their lives, and never will they understand or receive the true 5-Fold Ministry. Never! And when the message people turned down the 5-Fold Ministry, Spiritual cancer hit them, and they can only grow worse, spiritually speaking. They will never understand or receive the ministry of the seven thunders, a ministry quite distinct from the 5-Fold Ministry. It must pass over their head. Because all this speaks of progressive light, the progressive move of God at this end time. And once you turn down one move, you've got to turn down subsequent moves. There's just no way out of it.

All I can therefore say in closing is this: Be a Berean Christian, for: ***“These were more noble than those in Thessalonica, in that they received the Word with all readiness”*** (openness) ***“of mind, and SEARCHED THE SCRIPTURES DAILY, WHETHER THOSE THINGS WERE SO. THEREFORE MANY OF THEM BELIEVED”*** (Acts. 17:11, 12). That's how

it ought to be!

**The identity of the one portrayed by the mighty angel, the open scroll in his hand, his universal stance, his cry, the voices of seven symbolic thunders that John could have written had God not stopped him, the end of all things sworn to by this angel, all help to give a beautiful picture of an imminent prophetic event hanging right over Laodicea.**

I therefore can say that by the grace of God, we now have the revelation of what the seven thunders symbolize, nevertheless of the fact that their message and identity are a complete secret. They will prepare the Bride for the rapture, and through their ministry, we will know what the Seventh Seal holds. That is exactly right, for the seven thunders cannot be anything else. As a matter of Scriptural fact, I don't even find anything strange in their name, for Christ himself once surnamed James and John **“Boanerges, which is, THE SONS OF THUNDER”** - Mark. 3:17.

But notice, as I have tried to point out, the grafting in of the Gentiles into Christ must first be completed (finished) by the message (voice) of the Seventh Angel (the star witness or Messenger to Laodicea),

according to Revelation 10:7, before the seven thunders can take effect to round off God's dealing with the Bride. In other words, Revelation 10:7 fulfills before verses 1-6. And in God's numerology, 3 speaks of perfection, while 7 speaks of completion. We had seven local angels (pastors) to the seven local churches in Asia Minor John dispatched the book of Revelation to. We have had Seven Star Messengers to the Seven Church ages, typed by the seven Pastors to the Seven Local Churches in Asia Minor. We would now have seven anointed men called seven thunders ordained of God for this end time Bride. What does this give you? It gives you three sevens: It speaks of perfection and completion. ***"...But it shall come to pass, that at the evening time it shall be light"*** (Zec. 14: 7).

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## **ADDENDUM**

Shortly before going to the press, I had this sudden urge to add something here, from the message of the Prophet, to throw light on so much of what has been brought out of the Scripture of truth. But before then, I must stress that Revelation 10 : 1 & 2 cannot fulfil, until the 7th Seal, the last seal holding Christ on the throne, has been broken. Note that. It shows mercy is consequently over for the Gentiles. But right now, there is still grace unto salvation.

As such, you don't consider Revelation 10: 1 & 2, nor do you talk of seven thunders at all, until, and only until, the last Seal holding the scroll has been broken, and Christ is revealed on earth as portrayed in Revelation 10:1 & 2. For only after it is broken, does Christ come down in the spirit, as portrayed here by the angel. Saints, it is only after this setting is fulfilled, do the seven thunders utter their voices. Not before! Note that. In fact, their ministry is not even activated, until Christ first makes his loud cry, as depicted in verse 3!

Be settled therefore that the seven thunders cannot be revealed until the 7th Seal is broken. And if we know that the 7th Seal is not yet broken, then, the

seven thunders have not yet sounded. That is that.

Now turn with me to the Seven Seals book, page 576, paragraph 2: ***“Here now, we find that the sixth seal has been opened to us; we see it, and we know that this seventh seal C-A-N-N-O-T be broken to the public until that hour arrives”.*** (Here, the Prophet put the breaking of the 7th seal in the future. Let's skip to paragraph 5).

***“Now, we have in the completion here now, by the grace of God, all the mysteries of the six seals that's been seal up. And we understand and know here that the seventh seal is not to be known to the public”*** (i.e. at that time the other seals were broken. But let's see where he linked the seven thunders with the 7th seal, in paragraph 3).

***“Now, there was some reason that God let this seven voices be thundered BECAUSE IT M-U-S-T COME, see, for they ... we find that Christ, the Lamb, took the Book in his hand, and he opened that seventh seal”*** (i.e. in John's preview). ***“But you see, it's a hidden mystery. No one knows it. But it... right along with what he said: No one would know his coming”*** (i.e. mystical, secret coming for the Bride); ***“they also would not know about this seven thunder mystery. SO YOU SEE, IT'S CONNECTED TOGETHER”.*** (Let's now go to where he explained the

connection the seven thunders have with the 7th seal. We'll turn to page 575, paragraph 6).

***“Did you notice when the Jews asked him that?”*** (i.e. the disciples asked Jesus about when he would return). ***“You know when we compared the Scripture here with Matthew 24 with the Six seals, the Seventh Seal was left out; because, you see, Christ said only God, Himself, knew - not even the Angels. No wonder, it wasn't even written. You see, they hushed - nothing taken place then. Angels don't know it; nobody knows when he's coming. But there'll be a ... THERE'LL BE SEVEN V-O-I-C-E-S OF THESE THUNDERS THAT WILL R-E-V-E-A-L THE GREAT REVELATION AT THAT TIME”.*** (What then is the Seven Thunders?).

Saints, please understand, I am not trying to establish a teaching by quotes, for you don't do that, but only to let people see that even the Prophet's message bears out this seven thunders' symbolic revelation, many vehemently fight against today. They call it Jackson's revelation. But it is written: ***“Do not think that I will accuse you to the Father: there is one that accuseth you, even Moses (a type of Branham), in whom ye trust” - John. 5: 45.***

What does this tell you? **North, South, East or West, Truth is Truth.** May the Lord bless you.
